1.11 "DEBATING ECONOMIC"



1.16 "The importance of public speaking"



1.18 Visiting Lufra company



1.22 Debating Economics 2



gain the trust of viewers with the innovations, it brought to the Albanian audiovisual media, attracting the attention of different age groups, making Euronews one of the most followed media in the country.

Students were welcomed by Ms. Loneta Progni and Mr. Renaldo Salianji, journalists and presenters of the 'Miremengjes' morning program at Euronews, who shared with our students their experience in the field of journalism and media and explained the notion of 'media framing' and shared with the students Eronews policies regarding news broadcasting and the way news is delivered to the public. In this framework, students had the chance to discuss how journalists' rights and media freedom are being or not respected in Albania. Participants engaged in the discussion had the opportunity to give their own opinions and share their analyses with regard of what is the overall relationship between the media, the public, and politics in Albania.
